Parking is on Moneyrow Green, Bartletts Lane, or at the Memorial Hall. **St Michael's Hall** is behind St Michael's Church. The church is situated in the centre of Bray village and parking is in front of the church itself and on the grass area to the right towards the vicarage.

What is a Quiet Garden?

Quiet gardens are places where people meet together to reflect on topics that are part of the Christian faith. Private and public gardens are used and time is set aside for people to be still and enjoy the peace and beauty of nature. Meetings are open to all and newcomers are always welcome.

What happens at a meeting?
